

Bolderwood Trails

Explore the forest and catch a glimpse of wild Fallow deer.



The Deer Watch Trail [0.5 mile / 0.75 km / Under 1 hour]

The path runs to the accessible deer viewing platform where the wild Fallow deer are fed daily at approximately 2.00pm from Easter to September. The trail back to the car park is fairly steep and you may find it easier to return on the longer route which goes via the picnic area.

The Jubilee Trail [1 mile / 1.6 km / Under 1 hour]

If you feel comfortable on the first steep slope past the Radnor Stone, which also has a noticeable cross fall, you should cope well with this route. Return to the car park via the trail marked **A** and then past the Radnor stone as the marked trail is extremely steep.
